

REMINDERS ON KEEPING OUR DINING LOCATIONS SAFE

There are 14 Sodexo operated dining locations on the University of Massachusetts Dartmouth Campus that serve over 7,000 customer transactions on a daily basis. We need your help to keep our dining locations as safe as possible.

Here are some reminders of things you can do to keep the dining areas safe.

- Have a supply of fluids and light snacks in your room. See our dining resources on the website www.umassdfood.com.
- If you are experiencing influenza symptoms do not come to a dining location. Contact Health Services.
- Handwashing is the most important tool we have to help reduce the spread of H1N1. Please wash your hands as often as possible for at least 20 seconds, using a paper towel to turn the faucet on and off.
- Utilize the hand sanitizers provided at the entrance and exit of the dining halls.
- Please keep your student ID clean and sanitized on a daily basis. Don't put your ID in your mouth.
- Please do not reuse plates when returning to the line for additional items. Take a clean plate to prevent cross contamination.
- Please be sure to always use the utensils provided for the food. Never reach for the food or cookies with your bare hands.
- Don't share food by eating off the same plate or sharing the same glass.
